Dear Acting Commissioner Annucci:

In October 2021, the Offices of the New York State Inspector General was notified of potential misconduct by a correction officer employed with the New York State Department of Corrections and Community Supervision (DOCCS). An investigation was conducted, which found that likely acted in concert with his wife to submit falsified medical documentation ("out of work notes") to DOCCS, for the purpose of being placed on sick leave to which he was not entitled.
The investigation found that between August 2020 and September 2021, DOCCS received a series of out of work notes ¹ from Lewis County Health System (LCHS), purportedly signed and authorized by physicians, advising that was unfit for duty. At that
time, worked at Franklin Correctional Facility, a three-hour drive from his home. Upon receipt of the notes, DOCCS placed on sick leave, and subsequently extended his leave each time a new note was received from LCHS.
During this time, wife was employed by LCHS as a nurse practitioner and worked with treating physician, Dr. M.D., and his partner, Dr.
, M.D. In September 2021, LCHS learned that several out of work notes bearing the
signatures of Dr. and Dr. had been submitted to DOCCS on
behalf without the authorization of either doctor. Many of these notes referenced medical
examinations which had not been performed by either doctor. LCHS confronted wife, who admitted to creating and submitting several of the falsified notes to DOCCS on
behalf. wife immediately resigned from her position at LCHS.
