| On July 22, 2011, the New York State Inspector General received a complaint from the Department of Labor (DOL) Office of Special Investigation that a graph of the personal cellular telephone from an anonymous caller.  |

| The Inspector General's investigation determined that the text messages in question, which were unsolicited but non-threatening, originated from the telephone account of a last sent text messages to two other female DOL co-workers. During an interview conducted by our office, admitted that he sent text messages to a male co-worker, but denied having sent messages to and the other two female co-workers. He similarly denied ever having placed notes on a co-worker's desk. Similar to the texts, the notes left on desk were unsolicited, but non-threatening. |
| The Inspector General is referring this matter to DOL for review and appropriate action. Our investigative file, including interview reports, is available for your review upon request.  |
